☐ 2.4 \*certificate of successfully passed Technical Test (Euro-Test) according to Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/907. This proof is required only if the temporary occasional activity as a ski instructor is carried out outside a South Tyrolean ski school and the service provider does not benefit from the acquired rights in Article 7 of the above-mentioned Delegated Regulations (see note at page 2);

☐ 2.5 proof and details of the conclusion of a liability insurance against third parties for the profession of ski instructor, valid for Italy; (the insurance sum is at least euro 6.000.000,00);

☐ 2.6 in the case of professional qualifications from a country in which the profession of ski instructor is not regulated, detailed proof (period of work experience in days and certified by the employer) that the applicant has been working as a ski instructor for at least one year (12 month) during the last ten years preceding this application.

- ☐ 2.7 For the attached documents referred to in points 2.2, 2.4, 2.5 and 2.6, if they are in a language other than Italian or German, they must be accompanied by an English translation which is a faithful translation of the original language.

**The undersigned declares**, under his/her own responsibility and knowing the consequences in case of untrue or incomplete statements settled with D.P.R. n.445/2000, that all provided details are veracious.

**Privacy policy / processing of personal data (legislative Decree no. 196/2003)**

The Autonomous Province of Bozen/Bolzano is the legal entity. **Excerpt from Article 7 of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/907**

**Acquired rights**

1. Ski instructors who, before the date of entry into force of this Regulation, hold a professional card issued under the Memorandum shall benefit from the principle of automatic recognition as set out in Article 4(2).
2. Ski instructors who fall within the scope of this Regulation and who have passed both the Eurotest and the Eurosecurity test shall benefit from the principle of automatic recognition as set out in Article 4(2), where they also hold a qualification listed in Annex I.
3. Ski instructors who have obtained a qualification listed in Annex I in a Member State other than a signatory of the Memorandum at the moment of entry into force of this Regulation and are able to demonstrate professional experience of at least 200 days during the five years immediately preceding the entry into force of this Regulation shall benefit from the principle of automatic recognition as set out in Article 4(2).
